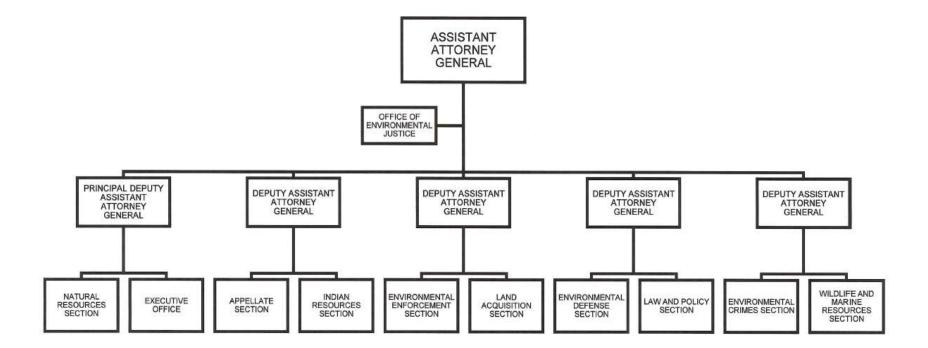

Annualization of new positions extends up to 2 years to provide entry level funding in the first year, with a 1 or 2-year progression to a journeyman level.
