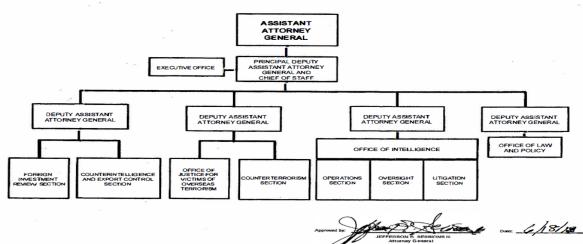

2 <u>Annualization of 2022 Approved Positions</u> This provides for the annualization of 6 new positions appropriated in 2022. For 2022 increases, this request includes an increase of \$1,000 for full-year payroll costs associated with these additional positions.	0	0	1
