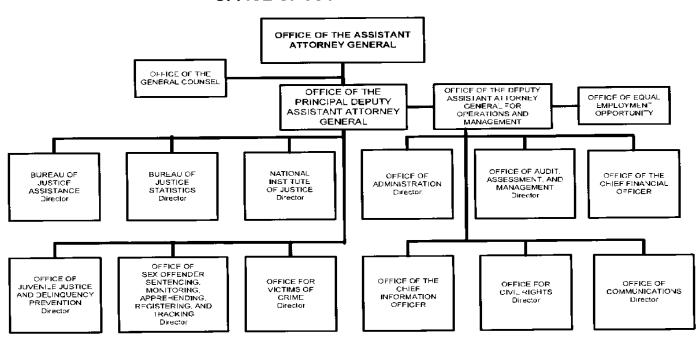
A: Organizational Chart

1 <u>2017 Pay Raise-1.6%:</u>			1,335
This request provides for a proposed 1.6 percent pay raise to be effective in January of 2017. The amount request, \$1,335K, represents the pay amounts for 3/4 of the fiscal year plus appropriate benefits (\$1,001K for pay and \$334K for benefits.)			
2 Annualization of 2016 Pay Raise:			294
This pay annualization represents first quarter amounts (October through December) of the 2015 pay increase of 1.3% included in the 2015 Appropriation. The amount requested \$294K, represents the pay amounts for 1/4 of the fiscal year plus appropriate benefits (\$215K for pay and \$79K for benefits).			
3 Change in Compensable Days:	0	0	-793
The decreased cost for two less compensable days in FY 2017 compared to FY 2016 is calculated by dividing the FY 2016 estimated personnel compensation \$91,066,720 and applicable benefits \$24,824,458 by 260 compensable days.			
4 Annualization of New Positions Approved in 2015:	0	36	2,914
Personnel:			
This provides for the annualization of <u>15</u> new positions appropriated in 2015. Annualization of new positions extends up to 3 years to provide entry level funding in the first year, with a 1 or 2-year progression to a journeyman level. For 2015 increases, this request includes an increase of <u>\$2,914K</u> for full-year payroll costs associated with these additional positions.			
5 Health Insurance:			
Effective January 2017, the component's contribution to Federal employees' health insurance increases by XX percent. Applied against the 2016 estimate of \$124K, the additional amount required is \$139K.			139
6 Retirement:			54
Agency retirement contributions increase as employees under CSRS retire and are replaced by FERS employees. Based on U.S. Department of Justice Agency estimates, we project that the DOJ workforce will convert from CSRS to FERS at a rate of 1.3 percent per year. The requested increase of \$54K is necessary to meet our increased retirement obligations as a result of this conversion.

The costs associated with GSA rent were derived through the use of an automated system, which uses the latest inventory data, including rate increases to be effective FY 2015 for each building currently occupied by Department of Justice components, as well as the costs of new space to be occupied. GSA provides data on the rate increases.

FY 2015

1. Language in Senate Report 113-181 requests that OJP report to the Senate Committee on Appropriations on a quarterly basis regarding grant programs that do not receive a sufficient number of applicants. *Target Response to the Committees February 2016 (FY 2015 Q4 report), and quarterly thereafter.*

FY 2016

- 1. Language in House Report 114-130 requests that OVC submit a report, no later than 90 days after enactment of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2016 (Public Law 114-113), on the steps it has taken to assist grantees in complying with new guidelines to revise performance metrics for both Victim Compensation and Victim Assistance formula grant programs. *Target Response to the Committees March 2016.*
- 2. Language in House Report 114-130 and Senate Report 114-66 requests that BJA assess the impact of establishing threshold enrollment and utilization rates of Prescription Drug Monitoring Programs (PDMPs) and, where enrollment and utilization rates are not 100 percent, assess the feasibility of requiring benchmarks for improvements in enrollment and utilization as grant eligibility criteria. The language further requests the Department to report, not later than 180 days after enactment of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2016 (Public Law 114-113), on this assessment, including the potential of prioritizing funding based on the goal of optimizing prescriber and dispenser enrollment and utilization rates for PDMPs by prescriber and dispensers. *Target Response to the Committees June 2016.*

Language in House Report 114-130 requests that OJP demonstrate and measure the impact of program models which combine vocational and intensive outpatient services for individuals recovering from addiction referred through the U.S. Probation and Pretrial Services System and report, no later than 90 days after enactment of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2016 (Public Law 114-113), on the status of these efforts. *Target Response to the Committees March 2016.*
- 4. Language in Senate Report 114-66 requests that Department detail, as part of its budget submission for fiscal year 2017 and future years, the actual costs for each grant office with respect to training, technical assistance, research and statistics, and peer review for the prior fiscal year, along with estimates of planned expenditures by each grant office in each of these categories for the current year and the budget year. *Target Response to the Committees February 2017 (as part of FY 2018 Budget)*.
- 5. Language in Senate Report 114-66 requests that OJP submit a quarterly report on grant programs that have not received a sufficient number of qualified applicants. *Target Response to Committees February 2016 (FY 2016 Q1/Q2 Report) and quarterly thereafter.*
- 6. Language in Senate Report 114-66 requests that, to strengthen Federal partnership across all jurisdictions, OJP review the criteria by which the OJP awards discretionary grants relating to gang violence and prevention under the State and Local Law Enforcement Assistance and Juvenile Justice Programs on a per capita basis of applicant cities and jurisdictions where gang activity and violent crime rates exceed national averages. The language further requests OJP to report on the relative success rate of awards granted to applicant cities and jurisdictions with disproportionately high gang and violent crime activity, including the murder rates of those cities and jurisdictions. The report should also consider the relative success rate of applicant cities and jurisdictions that have an established gang commission or community planning body, have completed the OJJDP gang assessment, and have consulted with or received technical assistance from the OJJDP National Gang Center regarding gang initiatives in the community. *Target Response to Committees April 2016*.
- 7. Language in Senate Report 114-66 requests that NIJ provide a report not later than 90 days after enactment of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2016 (Public Law 114-113) on its progress on continued development of a strategy and model for comprehensive school safety. *Target Response to Committees March 2016*.
