A. Organization Chart

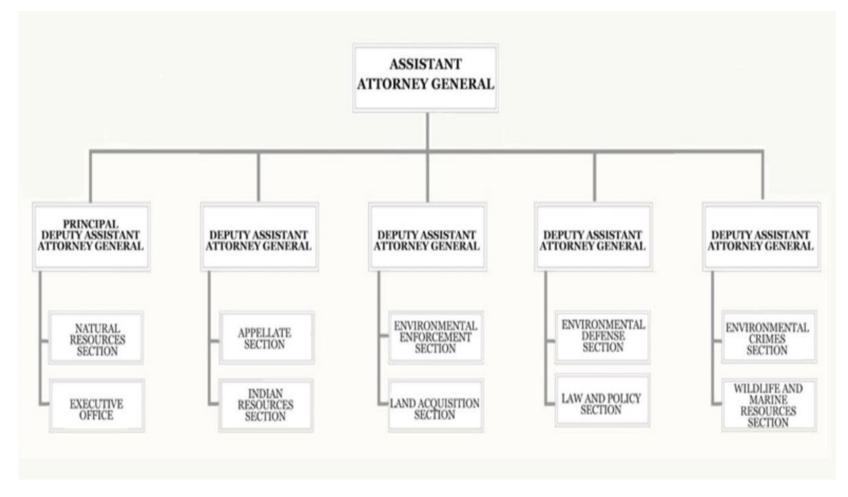
