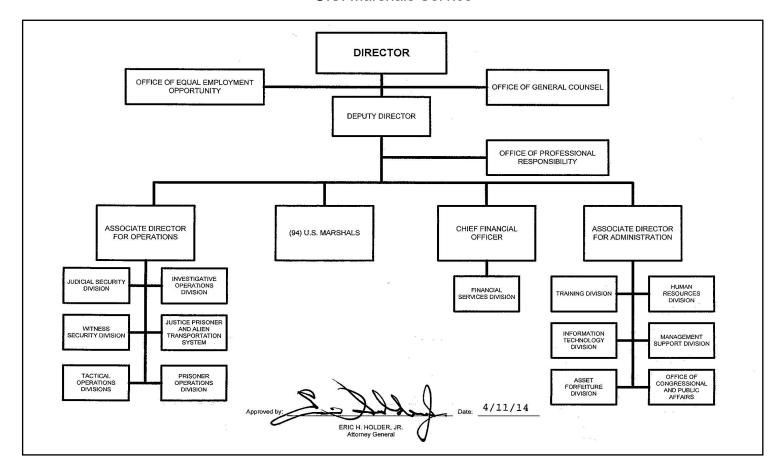
## **Organizational Chart**
