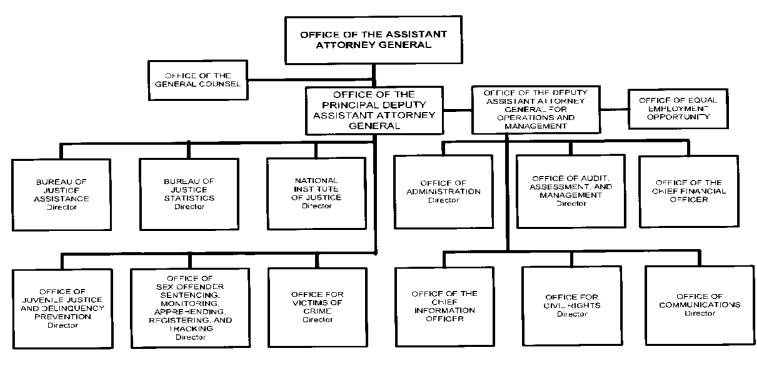
A: Organizational Chart

Status of Congressionally Requested Studies, Reports, and Evaluations Office of Justice Programs

FY 2019

1. Language in Senate Report 115-275 requests that the Department provided the Committee with a study on the number of trafficked victims who are convicted of crimes related to their trafficking, the types of crimes, and an analysis on how the Federal government can supplement state vacatur programs. The report shall be submitted to Congress within 30 days of enactment of this bill. *Response in progress; target date for completion is June 2020.*

2. Language in Senate Report 115-275 requests that OJP submit an annual report on grant programs that have not received a sufficient number of qualified applicants. Response in progress; target date for completion is June 2020.

3. Language in Senate Report 115-275 requests that NIJ provide a report to the Committee within one year of enactment of this act on its model and best practices for comprehensive school safety programs, including identifying the root causes of violence in schools. *Report due to Congress February 15, 2020.*

4. Language in Senate Report 115-275 requests that OJJDP report on the status of this pilot including the locations of CACs and military installations working together, the number of children served through these partnerships, and lessons learned from this pilot program. *Response in progress; target date for completion is March 2020.*

5. Language in House Report 115-704 requests that OVC report to the Committee, not later than 90 days after the enactment of this Act, on the actions it is taking to ensure Crime Victims Fund resources are reaching communities most affected by violence. *Response in progress; target date for completion is June 2020.*

6. Language in House Report 115-704 requests that Attorney General shall submit to the Committee on the Judiciary and the Committee on Appropriations of the Senate and the Committee on the Judiciary and the Committee on Appropriations of the House of Representatives a report on the Missing Americans Alert Program, as amended not later than 2 years after the date of enactment of this Act and every year thereafter. *Response in progress; target date for completion is June 2020.*

The FY 2021 President's Budget, consonant with Senate Report 116-127 (which reiterates the direction provided in P.L. 115-76), details the actual costs for each grant office with respect to training, technical assistance, research and statistics, and peer review for the prior fiscal year, along with estimates of planned expenditures by each grant office in each of these categories for the current year and the budget year. The requested information from OJP is below.

The FY 2020 and FY 2021 Peer review costs are estimates and are subject to change, based on the number of applications received and evolving programmatic needs and requirements.

^{2/} These amounts are for awards for the provision of training and technical assistance, as well as such training and technical assistance provided directly to the field, and include, among other things, amounts planned to be set aside under the authority of the appropriate CJS Appropriations Act. These amounts do not include Crime Victims Fund (CVF) monies. In general, CVF discretionary monies are available for "demonstration projects, program evaluations, compliance efforts, and training and technical assistance services," as well as "for fellowships and clinical internships" and for "services to victims of federal crime." The allocation among the different authorized purposes depends in large part on the quality of the various grant applications received and on the extent of the unmet needs of federal crime victims.

Note, in FY 2019 the percentage assessment from OJP programs was increased to 2.5%, but returned to 2% for FY 2020 Enacted.
