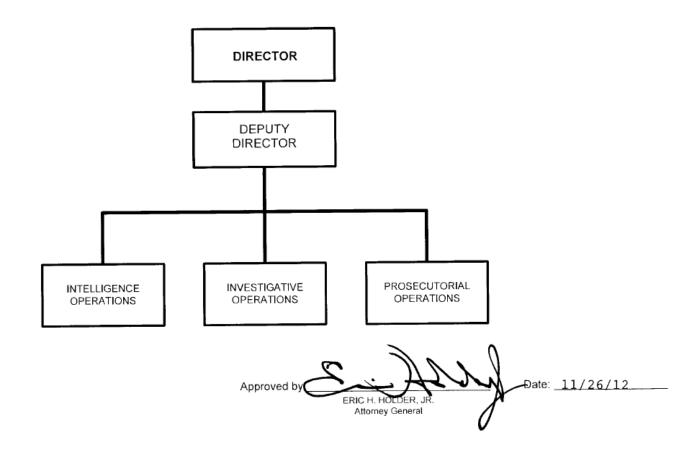
Organizational Chart
