

1 2022 Pay Raise - 2.7% This request provides for a proposed 2.7 percent pay raise to be effective in January of 2022. The amount requested, \$1,514,000, represents the pay amounts for 3/4 of the fiscal year plus appropriate benefits (\$1,060,000 for pay and \$454,000 for benefits.)	0	0	1,514
2 Annualization of 2021 Pay Raise This pay annualization represents first quarter amounts (October through December) of the 2021 pay increase of 1.0%. The amount requested, \$183,000, represents the pay amounts for 1/4 of the fiscal year plus appropriate benefits (\$128,100 for pay and \$\$4,900 for benefits.)	0	0	183
Semployees Compensation Fund The \$1,000 request reflects anticipated changes in payments to the Department of Labor for injury benefits under the Federal Employee Compensation Act.	0	0	1
4 FERS Rate Increase Effective October 1, 2021 (FY 2022), the new agency contribution rates of 18.4% (an increase of the prior rate of 17.3%) and 37.6% for law enforcement personnel (an increase of the prior rate of 35.8%), The amount requested, \$620,000, represents the funds needed to cover this increase.	0	0	620
