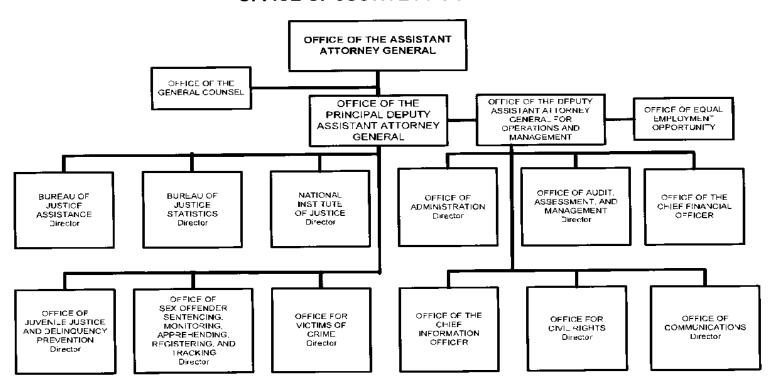
A: Organizational Chart

- 3. Language in House Report 115-704 requests that Attorney General shall submit to the Committee on the Judiciary and the Committee on Appropriations of the Senate and the Committee on the Judiciary and the Committee on Appropriations of the House of Representatives a report on the Missing Americans Alert Program, as amended not later than 2 years after the date of enactment of this Act and every year thereafter. Response in progress; target date for completion is June 2021.
