

As we have mentioned before, we think it very important to include ADF in these discussions, not least because they represent a number of different plaintiffs around the country who have brought suit against the illegal contraceptive mandate. Therefore I wanted to introduce you over email to Greg Baylor, who is the lead interlocutor at ADF on these issues. I think it would make sense for you two to make contact sometime in the near future.


