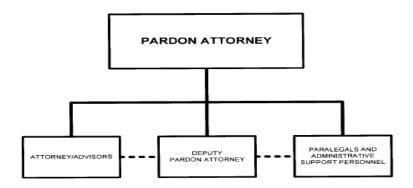
A: Organizational Chart

2 <u>FERS Rate Increase</u> Per 2018 OMB Circular A-11 section 32, Personnel Compensation, Benefits, and Related Costs, the agency contribution of regular retirement under FERS will increase from 13.7% to 16%. The FERS contribution for Law Enforcement retirement will increase from 30.1% to 33.4%. The amount requested, \$45,000, represents the funds needed to cover this increase.	0	0	45
3 <u>Health Insurance</u> Effective January 2020, the component's contribution to Federal employees' health insurance increases by 3.3 percent. Applied against the 2019 estimate of \$146,000, the additional amount required is \$5,000.	0	0	5
4 Retirement Agency retirement contributions increase as employees under CSRS retire and are replaced by FERS employees. The requested increase of \$13,000 is required to meet our commitment to GSA. The costs associated with GSA rent were derived through the use of an automated system, which uses the latest inventory data, including rate increases to be effective FY 2020 for each building currently occupied by Department of Justice components, as well as the costs of new space to be occupied.
