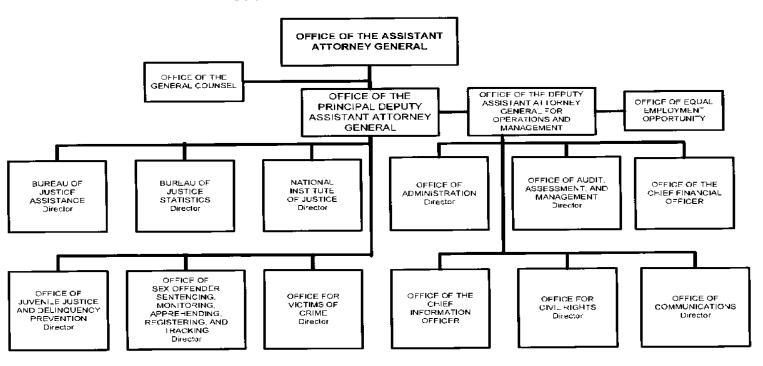

1 Change in Compensable Days: The increased cost for one compensable day in FY 2020 compared to FY 2019 is calculated by dividing the FY 2018 estimate personnel compensation by 261 compensable days.			464

Per 2018 OMB Circular A-11 section 32, Personnel Compensation, Benefits, and Related Costs, the agency contribution of regular retirement under FERS will increase from 13.7% to 16%. The FERS contribution for Law Enforcement retirement will increase from 30.1% to 33.4%. The amount requested, \$1.914 million, represents the funds needed to cover this increase.			
3 Employee Compensation Fund:			83
The \$7,000 request reflects anticipated changes in payments to the Department of Labor for injury benefits under the Federal Employee Compensation Act.

Effective January 2019, the component's contribution to Federal employees' health insurance increases by 3.6 percent. Applied against the 2017 estimate, the additional amount required is \$215,000			
5 Retirement:			154
Agency retirement contributions increase as employees under CSRS retire and are replaced by FERS employees. Based on U.S. Department of Justice Agency estimates, we project that the DOJ workforce will convert from CSRS to FERS at a rate of 0.8 percent per year, for both LEO and Non-LEO, based on the past 5 years of DOJ retirement data. The requested increase of \$154,000 is necessary to meet our increased retirement obligations as a result of this conversion.

The costs associated with GSA rent were derived through the use of an automated system, which uses the latest inventory data, including rate increases to be effective FY 2020 for each building currently occupied by Department of Justice components, as well as the costs of new space to be occupied. GSA provides data on the rate increases.

This includes Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Federal Protective Service charges, Justice Protective Service charges and other security services across the country. The requested increase of \$is required to meet these commitments.

#### Status of Congressionally Requested Studies, Reports, and Evaluations

Office of Justice Programs

#### **FY 2018**

- 1. Language in Senate Report 115-139 requests that BJA provide a report not later than 90 days after enactment of the Department of Justice Appropriations Act, 2018 (Public Law 115-141) on its progress in developing a strategy and model to serve as best practices for discovering and testing kits, training law enforcement, and supporting victims throughout the process as required by Public Law 113-235. Response submitted to the Committees November 2018.
- 2. Language in Senate Report 115-139 requests that OJP submit a quarterly report on grant programs that have not received a sufficient number of qualified applicants. Target date for consolidated response is June 2019.
- 3. Language in Senate Report 115-139 requests that the Department detail, as part of its budget submission for fiscal year 2019 and future years, the actual costs for each grant office with respect to training, technical assistance, research and statistics, and peer review for the prior fiscal year, along with estimates of planned expenditures by each grant office in each of these categories for the current year and the budget year. Response submitted to the Committees in February 2018 (as part of the FY 2019 President's Budget).
- 4. Language in Senate Report 115-139 requests that the Attorney General continue to submit a report within 90 days of enactment of the Department of Justice Appropriations Act, 2018 (Public Law 115-141) that includes the parameters and direction prescribed in Senate Report 114-239. Among other requests, the Attorney General is to provide an assessment to allow the Committees to better understand the extent to which DOJ grant programs overlap with one another along with a determination as to whether grant programs should be consolidated to mitigate the risk of unnecessary duplication. *Target response for report is May 2019*.
- 5. Language in Senate Report 115-139 requests that the Department provide a report not later than 90 days after enactment of this act with the following: an explanation of the methods and programs by which the DOJ will be assisting the State, local, and tribal forensic science community in tackling the opioid crisis through the work of the Subcommittee on Forensics; a plan as to how the Office of Forensic Investigative Sciences, within the National Institute of Justice, will solicit the input of State, county, local and tribal forensic science service providers, agencies and practitioners regarding grant programs; and how the DOJ plans to coordinate with NIST's Organization of Scientific Area Committees. *Target response for report is June 2019.*
- 6. Language in House Report 115-231 requests a report from the Bureau of Justice Statistics within 90 days of the enactment of the Department of Justice Appropriations Act, 2018 (Public Law 115-141) analyzing what the Bureau is doing to ensure Second Chance Act funding is reaching communities where the largest populations of formerly incarcerated people return. Target response for report is August 2019.
- 7. Language in House Report 115-231 directs the Department to study whether immersive, real-life scenario-based training improves law enforcement officer performance, increases police safety, and reduces use-of-force incidents, deadly force, and citizen complaints, and to report to the Committee not later than 90 days after enactment of the Department of Justice Appropriations Act, 2018 (Public Law 115-141). Response submitted to the Committees February 2019.
- 8. Language in House Report 115-231 requests that OVC report to the Committee, not later than 90 days after enactment of the Department of Justice Appropriations Act, 2018, (Public Law 115-141), on the actions they are taking to ensure Crime Victims Fund resources are reaching communities most affected by violence. Response submitted to the Committees December 2018.
