Pay and Benefits 1 2020 Pay Raise - 2.6% This pay annualization represents first quarter amounts (October through December) of the 2020 pay increase of 2.6% percent included in the FY 2020 enacted appropriations. The amount requested, \$62,000, represents the pay amounts for 1/4 of the fiscal year plus appropriate benefits.	0	0	62
2 2021 Pay Raise and Awards Increase Per OMB A-11 guidance, section 32.1, Personnel Compensation, the agency must reflect an increase in awards spending for non-SES/SL/ST from FY 2020 to FY 2021. This increase should be no less than 1 percent point of FY 2021 non-SES/SL/ST salary spending. The amount requested is \$76,000. In addition, this request provides for a proposed 1 percent pay raise for FY 2021 to be effective in January 2021.
