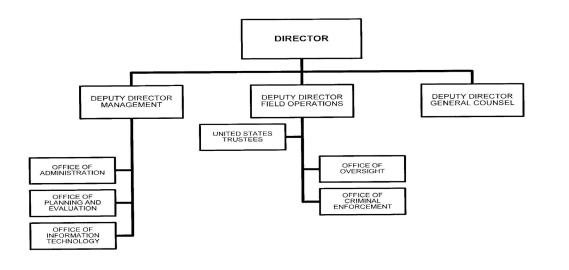
# **A: Organizational Chart**

/1 The USTP devotes resources to pursuing cost savings in technology, but is not providing specific resource amounts expended due to the complexity of isolating the time devoted by staff to these tasks. Examples of the Program's cost-saving initiatives in IT include the transition of systems to the cloud, including the Program's migration of its servers for electronic file and printing capabilities, which was completed in FY 2019. Also in FY 2019, the Program initiated a multi-year modernization project of its critical information technology systems which is anticipated to result in increased functionality, annual cost savings and operational efficiencies by eliminating obsolete systems, automating functions, and improving user interfaces as well as the Program's supervisory Information Technology and Administrative Officer staff who deliver training to the Program.

In addition, this request provides for a proposed 1 percent pay raise for FY 2021 to be effective in January 2021. The FERS contribution for Law Enforcement retirement will increase from 33.4% to 35.8%. The amount requested, \$1,458,000, represents the funds needed to cover this increase. 6 Position/FTE Adjustment -[1] 39 In the past decade, the Program's workforce has declined by about a guarter and currently, over a guarter of staff are retirement-eligible. The Program has consequently accelerated hiring efforts and anticipates the full impact to FTEs will be realized in FY 2021. The downward adjustment of the position reflects a reallocation of one position from reimbursable to direct.

#### Carryover:

The USTP's carryover in FY 2020 reflects a higher than historical amount due to an intensive de-obligation effort to ensure a seamless transition to a new financial management system in FY 2019. A portion of these funds will be used to sustain a multi-year modernization project of critical Program information technology systems.

#### **Recoveries/Refunds:**

The USTP estimates \$5 million in recoveries for FY 2020 and has authority to refund up to \$10 million in prior-year quarterly fees, to be funded by offsetting collections received in FY 2020 or by the balance in the United States Trustee System Fund if offsetting collections are insufficient. The USTP will use recovered funds for upwards adjustments to obligations and to address non-recurring program needs such as start-up costs related to the new duties provided for under the Small Business Reorganization Act, Pub. L. No. 116-54, enacted in August 2019, as well as information technology and facilities projects. The estimate reflects a continuation of an intensive deobligation effort, commenced prior to FY 2019, to ensure a seamless transition to a new financial management system.

In FY 2021, the USTP estimates spending \$2.8 million in non-SES awards, equivalent to 2.3% of the estimated \$124.2 million in non-SES salaries for the year. The estimated increase in awards over FY 2020 to FY 2021 is \$1.2 million, equivalent to 1% of FY 2021 non-SES salaries.
